A Brief Report

The IQAC and the Department of Botany in association with EEVA Patent Services (Eeva IP & IT Services Pvt. Ltd.), Hyderabad & Visakhapatnam have organized a one-day Capacity Building Programme for Teaching Staff of the college to create awareness on Intellectual Property Rights.

Inaugurating the programme, Dr.K.Ramachandra, the principal of the college stated the importance of IPR in the current academic scenario and asserted that this programme is organized for fostering research environment in the institution.

Sri M. Srinivas, Attorney, IPR acted as the Resource Person for four sessions of the CBP and shared valuable information about the significance of IPR in protecting and safeguarding inventions and innovations. He gave a detailed explanation about the different types of IPR. In the second session participants were informed about the procedure for filing patent application. The various parts of the patent application were talked about in detail.

Information about Trademarks, Copyrights and Trade Secrets was shared with the participants. Further, the basics of industrial designs were dealt with in detail. Participants were made aware of the classification of industrial designs, their filing and legal provisions related to them.

The participants interacted with the resource person periodically. They shared their ideas with the resource person and also got their doubts related to IPRs clarified.

In addition to the above, information about IPR-Institutions Perspective, Trademarks in India, Geographical Indications and Technology was also shared to the participants.

The participants were thoroughly satisfied with the programme and expressed that this CBP helped them gain valuable and educative experience. They expressed their willingness to participate in more programmes of such kind in future.

Sri M. Srinivas (the Resource Person) as the representative of EEVA Patent Services acceded to collaborate with the college in creating awareness about IPRs in days to come. Government
