ACTION PLAN 2012-'13

- The Department of Mathematics proposes to celebrate Maths Day in connection with the Birthday Celebrations of the greatest Indian mathematician Srinivasa Ramanajan.
- The Department of mathematics wishes to conduct certificate course on "Quantative Aptitude" for degree students in the month of December, 2013.
- The Department of Maths is planning to conduct a workshop in Mathes in January, 2014.
- The Department of English proposes to train the newly recruited English Lecturers in the state under ELF Program.
- The Department of English also proposes to conduct an outreach workshop to all the lecturers of the other departments in the college on the Communicative method of teaching.
- The Department of English proposes to collaborate with AKNU, local Junior and Degree colleges besides the engineering colleges in improving Communication Skills among the students. There was an exchange of guest lecturers.
- The Alumni Association of the college proposes to has contact all the old students living at various places in India and abroad to raise funds for the construction of an open auditorium.
- All the Departments plan to conduct Field Trips, Study Tours and Guest Lecturers as proposed in the previous year.
- The Department of Hindi proposes to conduct a National Seminar.
- The NSS, NCC, Red Ribbon Club propose to have conduct various activities such as Blood Donation Camp, Rallies, Rural Sensitization Programs, Literacy Programs etc. as planned earlier.
- The Department of Physics proposes to consstruct an e-classroom for facilitating the ICT based teaching at the UG and PG levels.

Government College (Autonomous), Rajahmundry

A Brief History

Government College, Rajahmundry started functioning as a Zilla school in 1853 and was upgraded as a Provincial school of Madras presidency in 1868. This was the beginning of the unbroken story of Government College Rajahmundry which completed 158 years of its mammoth service The high school classes were discontinued in 1885 and the college has since remained exclusively as college for University classes. The College was affiliated to University of Madras in 1891.

Rajahmundry is situated on the banks of the holy river Godavari, known as the Dakshina Ganga in Andhra Pradesh. It was the capital city of Eastern Chalukyan empire which reached the heights of its glory during the reign of King Raja Raja Narendra in the 11th century. It was a seat of great learning where art, literature and trade flourished to their perfection. Adikavi Nannayya, the court poet of Raja Raja Narendra and the first poet of Telugu Literature who translated the Sanskrit Version of the Mahabharatha into Telugu belongs to this place.

At the commencement of 19th century, the Government College at Rajahmundry was one of the only three graded Colleges maintained by the Government of Madras Presidency, and the other two being the Presidency College, Chennai and the Kumbakonam College, Kumbakonam. The great people who served this institution include Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, the most influential scholars of comparative religion and philosophy, worked as a faculty member in the Department of Philosophy (1916-1919) in this institution. He was the first Vice-President of India (1952–1962), and also served as second President (1962–1967) of India.

Another stalwart Sri. Kandukuri Veeresalingam Pantulu, a social reformer of Andhra Pradesh worked in this college as a faculty member in Telugu Department during the year 1876-77. He is widely considered as the man who first brought about the Renaissance in Telugu people and Telugu literature. He fought for the emancipation and empowerment of women way back in 1910.

Some of the students of this Alma mater, who later turned into giants in various spheres were Sri K.V.Reddy Naidu, Acting Governor in 1936 in Madras Presidency, Sri Tanguturi Prakasam

Panthulu, known as Andhra Kesari (literally, the Lion of Andhra) and the first Chief Minister of the erstwhile Madras province that was to become Andhra State, Sri Varahagiri Jogiah Panthulu, illustrious father of V.V.Giri former President of India, Sri V.K.Krishna Menon, Former Defence Minister of India and Sri P.S.Rao, Chairman, Damodar Valley Corporation, former Governor of Kerala and an awardee of Padmabhushan.

The college also produced some outstanding literary and artistic stalwarts like Sri Damerla Rama Rao, Freedom fighters like Sri Gadicherla Harisarvottama Rao who took active part in Vandematharam Movement in pre-independence era and Sri Koka Subba Rao, the former Chief Justice of Supreme Court. The college was affiliated to Andhra University in 1926. The Centenary celebrations of the College were held in February 1960, with Sri C.D.Deshmukh, the then Chairman of U.G.C, as President.

Undergraduate courses were started in the college from 1930. At present, the college offers instruction in 22 UG programmes and 9 PG programmes. The Department of Chemistry has been recognized by Andhra University as Research center and it is offering M.Phil and Ph.D courses in Chemistry and the Department has produced 2 Ph.Ds and 5 M.Phils so far. Recently, the Department of Physics has also been recognized as a Research Centre by Andhra University, Visakhapatnam. Some scholars are carrying out research in the Departments of Physics and Mathematics for M.Phil and Ph.D degrees.

Metcalfe Boys Hostel, attached to the college was started in July 1950. The UGC granted Autonomous status to this college during the academic year 2000-2001 and it is extended till 2013. Under the Autonomous set up, the college introduced Semester System. The college was accredited at grade 'A' by NAAC in 2004. Some of the prominent British Principals who worked in this institution were E.P.Metcalfe (1877-1896), E.W.Middlemast (1896 -1903), Mark Hunter (1903 - 1909), O.J.Couldrey (1909-1919), C.J.Wilkinson (1919 -1921). The college now caters to the educational needs of more than 3000 students with various groups and combinations of study at UG and PG levels.

1. ACTIVITIES REFLECTING THE GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE INSTITUTION:

The following activities have been undertaken by the various wings of the college reflecting the goals and objectives of the college. "Encouraging global competence and Research with human face" are the goals of the institution and the objectives are "providing standard education and employability through developing the all-round personality of the student". The College leaves no stone unturned in directing all efforts to achieve the goals and objectives of the college. Accordingly the following activities have been undertaken by various departments to promote employability through global skills and to ensure all round development of the students.

 Res.Centre./2010. This is being used to facilitate the Ph.D and M.Phil students doing
 research on Crystal Growth and Nano Materials.
- All the departments of the college organized extension lectures in different verticals and horizontals by inviting scholars, professors and other specialists in the field of Higher Education for the benefit of students.
- The faculty of the college is very active in undertaking the UGC sponsored Minor Research Projects.

- The Website <u>www.govtcollegerjv.org</u> provides information regarding the history of the
 college, celebrities among the alumni, infrastructure available, admissions, fee structure,
 curriculum, examination pattern, faculty and their qualifications, results, scholarships
 offered, Academic Calendar etc.
- Youth Festival, a District Level 1 day cultural fest was conducted in Govt. College Rajahmundry.
- The Women Empowerment Cell organized activities like Elocution, Essay Writing for girl students Extension Lectures on Opportunities for Women, Greeting Card Preparation and Rangoli.

Uniform & Id Cards

• The college has introduced uniform to students for equality and identity to eliminate all types of disparities among the students. The students are also supplied with ID Cards.

JKC

- The JKC provides placements to the students in various MNCs like, INFOSYS, Satyam, Genpact. The JKC has been set up with a purpose to unleash potential of the students.
 The JKC also conducts campus Recruitments at the end of every year.
- 6 batches of students are trained every year each for a duration of 3 months.
- 84 students were selected in the campus drive held by 13 reputed organizations across the state.
- It is a similar project sponsored by Hansa Solutions, a Hyderabad based software organization. It aims at providing employment training to 100 students in 2 batches in Communication skills and Technical Skills so as to enable them grab opportunities in MNC Drives.

Women Development Council

The Women Development Council was constituted on 3-03-2010 under the chairmanship
of Dr.G.S.Moses, Principal, Govt. College (A) Rajahmundry. All teaching and non
teaching women staff constitutes the members of the committee. The motto of this

council is to help the girl students of the institution and women at large by sensitizing them of their rights and duties.

The WDC reviewed the complaints and action taken register periodically. Activities Register and a record of girl students data, a Resolutions Register are maintained by the WDC. Guidance is extended to students with the help of 2 lecturers namely Dr. K.Jyothi, Lect. in Physics and Dr. Balamani, Lect. in Botany are specially allotted for this purpose. Unless urgent, complaints of the girl students will be heard every Saturday and resolved or counseled. A complaint box is also set up for girl students to lodge complaints.

Anti Ragging Committee

The anti ragging Committee was constituted with the Senior Most faculty of the college.
 The committee maintains discipline in the college to ensure congenial academic atmosphere on the premises. It takes all possible measures to prevent incidents of ragging on the premises. It investigates into the complaints of ragging, finds facts and recommends punishments in case ragging is proved.

Technology Up Gradation

- All the Departments of the college have been supplied with Computers.
- The college has a tie up with the BSNL to supply broadband internet at concessional price to all the departments of the college.
- The old systems have been upgraded.
- Proposals are underway to provide the wifi facility.
- The reading room has been provided with two systems with a provision for 24 hrs. Broad Band

Extracurricular Activities

 Social service activities by NSS, NCC, Women Development Council and Red Ribbon Club are conducted periodically.

NSS Activities

- 1st October 2012 observed as National blood donation Day by NSS units in which 66 volunteers have been participated. In this connection a blood donation camp was conducted. 117 units blood donated to Sri Sanjeevini blood bank.
- 14th November 2012 observed as Children Day and 56 NSS volunteers participated
- On 1st December 2012 conducted a huge rally to create AIDS awareness among the public with 500 NSS and UG, PG students.

NCC Activities (Boys & Girls Wings)

 The NCC cadets participated in National Integration Camp (NIC), All India Tracking camp, Annual Training Camp, etc. A large number of NCC cadets got selected in police and Defence services. The "C" Certificate holders got seats in various universities and reputed government organizations.

Field Visits

 Field Visits are conducted by almost all the Departments to areas specific to their area of study. They provided hands on experience to the students. The field visits included industrial places like Sugar Factories, AP Paper Mill, historical places like Draksharama and Amaravathi and Scientific Centres like IASc Bangalore, Atomic Power Station, Kalpakkam, Educational Centres like the Central University, Hyderabad.

2. NEW ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES INITIATED (UG AND PG):

- The Department of Telugu proposes to introduce a new course in B.A with Economics, History and Special Telugu.
- Career Oriented Program is a UGC sponsored program conducted with the collaboration
 of the Departments of English and Commerce. It is a 3 year program which provides a
 Certificate at the end of I year, a Diploma at the end of II year and an Advanced Diploma
 at the end of Final year. Students are trained in Basic Communication Skills and
 Personality Development.

Tally Certificate is another Course conducted by the Department of Commerce. It is a 2
months course offered in collaboration with JKC. A certificate is issued on the successful
completion of the course.

3. INNOVATIONS IN CURRICULAR DESIGN AND TRANSACTION

- All the innovative programs in curriculum design and methodologies adopted for the transaction are being implemented successfully during 2012-13 also.
- The Mana TV is being used as a satellite program to provide audio visual supplement by expert lecturers to the students across the state. All the programs of the Mana TV are being viewed by the students according to the schedule.

4. INTER-DISCIPLINARY PROGRAMS STARTED:

Inter-disciplinary programs enhance the student ability to acquire additional competencies. They also ensure job opportunities. The following interdisciplinary programs already started are continued this academic year also.

- The Department of Zoology is continuing specialization on 'Fisheries' realizing that Aqua Culture is fast rising in the East Godavari District.
- The Department of Microbiology is continuing Interdisciplinary Study Projects with the Dept. of Statistics.
- Two new papers namely 'Computer Fundamentals' Or 'Computer Skills' for all the I
 year UG students and 'Office Automation Tools' for all the II year are still being
 continued.
- Academically weak students and backlog students of present and past were given intensive remedial coaching in all the subjects as per the UGC Guidelines.

5. EXAMINATION REFORMS IMPLEMENTED:

Reforms in the examinations ensure accuracy, speed and reliability. Number reforms
have been undertaken in the Examination Branch. Some of them are as follows:

Credit System

- Credit system is being continued for awarding grades instead of the existing class awarding system at the end of Degree. There are a total of 120 credits for all the 6 semesters. Out of them 30 credits are given for part-1 [Languages] and 90 credits for Part II {group Subjects]. 10 extra credits have been awarded based on students' participation in co-curricular and extra curricular activities such as NCC, NSS, Sports, Cultural Activities and Blood Donation etc.
- Since the college is affiliated to Andhra University, reforms in Examinations are executed as per the norms and conditions of the university from time to time.
- 40% Practical Component introduced for 10 marks out of 25 allotted for Viva as part of Internal Assessment.
- Average of the 2 internal practical tests taken for computation of final practical marks.
- Final year Students having not more than 2 backlogs papers allowed for Instant exams.
- The Academic year is divided in to TWO Semester.
- The First, Third and fifth Semesters span from June to October with minimum of 90 instruction days.
- The Second, fourth and Sixth Semesters span from November to March with a Minimum of 90 instruction days.
- Semester end exams are conducted in the months of October and March.
- Unit Tests are being conducted.
- Assignments are being given to students
- Pre-final examinations are also conducted.


Study project:

- The Students of Political Science have also prepared a project on the Historical perspective of the Satyanarayana Temple, Annavaram.


