1.	Education with practical Exposure	1. Apprenticeship Embedded Degree programs (AEDP) are prioritized. For the academic year 2023-24: • AEDP programs in Banking Financial services and Insurance is introduced in collaboration with Sector Skill Council for BFSI. • BBA Event Management is introduced with Internship component. • B.Com Accounting is introduced with special focus on practical component. 2. Mandatory Internships embedded in the curriculum across 39 programs are designed with specific Industry. 3. Laboratories are maintained and augmented. 4. To meet the learning needs of the students the college is run from 9 am to 5 Pm for the even semesters and 8 am to 6 Pm during the odd semesters. 5. Library is accessible physically from 8

2.	Teaching – Learning processes	1. Class Rooms are equipped with interactive boards. 2. Extensive usage of ICT based teaching pedagogies is encouraged and facilitated. 3. Institutional LMS Development is prioritized. 4. Outcome based Education is scientifically structured to ensure the desired results.
3.	Support for Sports and Cultural Activities.	1. Am phi Theatre is under establishment wherein the students can showcase their talents. 2. Sports and games activities are organized by the Institution and also in collaboration with AKNU University, Sports Authority of India for laying and maintaining sports facilities (grounds, courts, fields,...) and local Government and Non-government authorities in organizing various events at local, University, National levels. 3. Sports, Library and cultural events are practiced at Institution by the respective departments and incorporated in the time table and grounds, courts and indoor games are accessible to students and faculty.
4.	Campus Drives	1. Campus drives are arranged by the institution inviting the industry. 2. Commissionerate of Collegiate Education also facilitates campus drives for all colleges under 10 Identified NRC groups. 3. Campus drives are also organized in collaboration with district authorities.
5.	Computer labs	1. 250 computers are procured through government E portal to facilitate access to more number of students.

6	Reading Room	The sprawling green spaces on the campus will be made use to extend reading facilities. Project report for Central library with more reading space and modern learning facilities is submitted and awaiting approval from authorities.
7.	MoU with Forest Department	The authorities are approached and agreement for understanding is pursued by life sciences departments
8	Communication skills	Department of English, Telugu, Hindi, and Sanskrit promote communication skills through their club activities. Special workshops, Training programs, soft skill sessions are organized for improving communication skills.
9.	Include industrial related topic into the concerned syllabus.	Logistics, Renewable Energy, AI, Data analysis, IOT, Practical sciences, banking, financial services, event management, retail operations, and computer applications are included in the curriculum to enhance understanding of the real time applications of theory.
10	Separate waiting rooms	Existing waiting rooms are modernized and new restroom for girls and boys are created to protect privacy of gender.
11.	Active Incubation centre	The activities under incubation are planned in a big way. A separate building for incubation is under way. The new establishment is facilitated with all modern equipment and amenities to support students training, start-up activities and commercialization of products. Collaboration with Government agencies like NIESbud and Non-Government organization COWE, Hansa solutions, Centre for Skill Development are made.
