Literary Works and Themes for Consideration

The review focused on several specific texts and thematic areas:

- * Hithopadesham: Inclusion of the theme "War - Benefit" to impart certain values.
- * Sathakalu: Inclusion of collections of verses for human development and nurturing a love for literature.
- * Modern vs. Traditional Literature: Critique of developing modern prose with an ancient theme; suggestion to include the poetry of Jashuva instead.
- * Dalit Literature: Inclusion of works by Inaak garu to promote human values.
- * Kopparthi's "CHEMISTRY OF TEARS."
- * Pragathi's "Coal Stove": A modern story comparing a mother's love to a coal stove, discussing a mother's hard work and suffering, and the need for environmental protection.
- * Puranic Characters: Inclusion of themes like going to fight Ravana and getting immersed in the characters.
- * Ravisastri's work: Transformation from idealism to humanism.
- * "Approval is sought to offer 'Functional Telugu' as a certificate course. benefits that candidates will gain from this course and explain how this course will enhance the students' employability."

DISCUSSION AND DELIBERATION

The participants presented arguments for and against certain inclusions, reflecting on the curriculum's objectives and literary merit.

- * Rationale for Inclusions: Argued for works based on their benefit to student values and literary appreciation, specifically Hithopadesham, Sathakalu, and Inaak garu's works.
- * Literary Critique and Alternative: Presented a critical viewpoint against mixing modern prose with ancient themes, which served as the basis for suggesting Jashuva's poetry.
- * Themes of "Coal Stove": Explained that the story covers a mother's love, suffering, and the need for environmental protection.
- * Formal Suggestion: Formally suggested replacing "Coal Stove" with the works of Thilak or "Amaravati Kathalu." (This suggestion was an alternative to earlier proposals to replace it with Kashayva
