Summary of the Event:

An interdisciplinary guest lecture on "Financial Management in Daily Life" was delivered by Sri R. Ramarao, a Lecturer in Commerce from GDC Elamanchili, specifically tailored for physics students. The lecture aimed to bridge the gap between the seemingly disparate fields of physics and financial management, emphasizing the practical application of financial concepts in everyday life.

Sri R. Ramarao introduced the students to fundamental financial principles, including budgeting, saving, and investing, and demonstrated how these principles are crucial not only in personal finance but also in professional settings, such as research funding and project management. He highlighted the importance of financial literacy in making informed decisions, both in personal life and in the context of scientific endeavors.
