### ABOUT THE COLLEGE:

The Government Degree College, Rampachodavaram is situated near the river Godavari in Rampachodavaram village, which is 50 kilometers away from Rajamahendravaram in East Godavari District (Chavali Sub-Region, Rajamahendravaram Taluk area surrounded by the 1 Andhra States). This region is popularly known as 'Agony' in Andhra Pradesh. The Government of Andhra Pradesh (presently) purchased 9.1 acres of land for the construction of buildings. It was offered to Andhra University and the classes were run in Government Degree College, Rampachodavaram. Later the college was shifted to its own building in 1987. The College is recognized by UGC, under sections 2(f) and 12 (B) of the UGC Act 1956. From 2019 the college got recognized by Andhra Pradesh Skill Development Corporation to March 2023 the college recognized with NAAC, B grade. In the year 2024-25 (Present Year) a total of 491 students are pursuing their education and are monitored by 19 teaching staff. The College has a 4 km long, 80 m wide road, 80 m wide road, 80 m wide road, 80 m wide road. The college offers conventional programmes (B.A. HON. B.COM. GEN.), B.Sc. M.C., B.Z., B.T. and B.Com. Computer Applications. In 2022-23 Single Mode system was introduced in 2023-24 with honours degree in BA History, Economics, B.Sc. Chemistry, Botany and B.Com. Computer Applications. The dynamic and committed teachers of the college serve the student community with the utmost commitment and relevant teaching methodologies. The college established 100% NAAC 'B' grade in this academic year 2024-25.

### DEPARTMENT OF HISTORY

Established in the academic year 1983-84, the Department of History was one of the founding departments of Government Degree College, Rampachodavaram. It currently has approximately 115 students enrolled. Every year, outgoing History students secure ranks in B.Ed and PG entrance exams. The HST (History, Economics, and Political Science) program was introduced in 1983 with Telugu as the medium of instruction. In 2017-18, the department adopted the cluster system, further enhancing the academic framework. Recognizing the increasing interest in History, the college formally established a dedicated History major in 2023 with an initial intake capacity of 40 students. At present, there are 40 first-year students, 21 second-year students, and 12 third-year students enrolled in the HST convention. The department follows a well-rounded, multidisciplinary approach, organizing a variety of activities to enhance both academic and personal development. These initiatives include Student Seminars, Quizzes, Guest lectures, their learning sessions, such activities encourage students to engage deeply with historical content while also improving their critical thinking and public speaking skills. Additionally, project work is integrated into the curriculum, allowing students to conduct research, collaborate with peers, and present their findings. This hands-on experience enhances their historical inquiry, analysis, and communication skills to foster a stimulating academic environment. The department remains committed to providing an engaging and supportive learning community. As part of its academic initiatives, the Department of History successfully conducted a National Webinar on January 22, 2022.

### DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE

The Department of Political Science was one of the founding departments of the Govt. Degree College, Rampachodavaram. The department focuses on the study of government systems, political theories, and public policies and aims to develop critical thinking, analytical skills, and knowledge of political structures and encourages students to understand governance, democracy, and international relations. The department covers subjects like Indian Constitution, Political Theory, Public Administration, International Relations, and Comparative Politics. It includes interdisciplinary approaches with History and Economics. The department organizes guest lectures, seminars, and workshops by political analysts and academicians for the academic development of students. To encourage students, the department offers internships, model parliament sessions, and political awareness programs. From the academic year 2023-24, Political Science department introduced an honors subject. Experienced faculty members with expertise in different political domains. The department encourages digital learning, internships, and study tours to parliaments and courts.
