Report on Student Extension Activity Conducted by the Department of English: Basics of English Grammar for 9th Standard Students

Date: 17-03-2025 to 21-03-2025

Venue: Nehru Nagar Municipal High School, Rajahmundry.

The Department of English organized a 5 day student extension activity titled Basics in English Grammar for 9th standard students from 17-03-2025 to 21-03-2025. Aimed at strengthening foundational grammar skills focused on key topics such as “Tenses, Parts of Speech, Active and Passive Voice, Degrees of Comparison, and Articles”. The initiative sought to enhance students’ communication proficiency, writing accuracy, and confidence in English.

Objectives

1. To familiarize students with core grammar components essential for academic success.
2. To provide practical understanding through interactive learning.
3. To improve accuracy in written and spoken English.
4. To encourage application of grammar rules in daily communication.
5. To build confidence through collaborative activities.

Coverage of Topics

1. Tenses: Structure and usage of 12 verb tenses with examples.
2. Parts of Speech: Functions of Nouns, Pronouns, Verbs, Adverbs, Adjectives, Prepositions, Conjunctions, and Interjections.
3. Active & Passive Voice: Sentence restructuring rules and contextual applications.
4. Degrees of Comparison: Formation of Comparative and Superlative Adjectives.
5. Articles: Rules for Definite (the) and Indefinite (a, an) articles.

Student Engagement

- 85 students. participated actively in role-plays, group discussions, and quizzes.
- Visual aids.

Outcomes and Benefits

1. Improved Understanding: Post-activity assessments showed 40% average score increase compared to pre-tests.
2. Enhanced Writing Skills: 75% of students demonstrated correct tense and article usage in practice essays.
3. Confidence Boost: 90% of participants reported feeling more confident in grammar applications.

Conclusion

The activity successfully bridged gaps in foundational grammar knowledge, equipping students with tools for academic and real-world communication. Positive feedback underscores the need for such initiatives.
