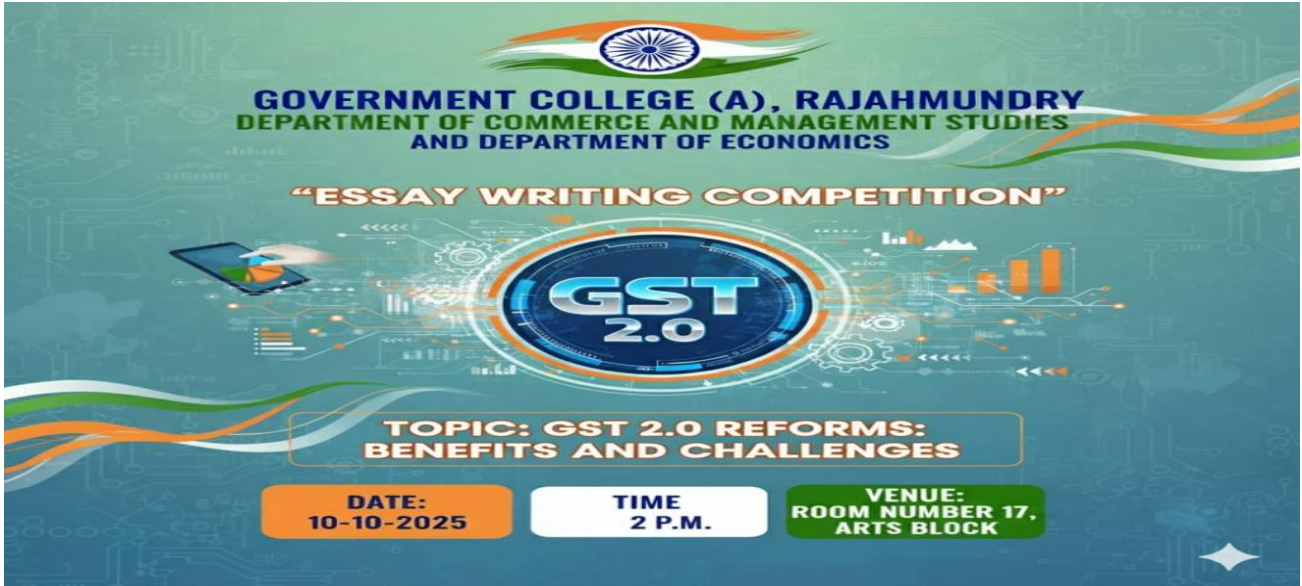


Report on Essay Writing Competition

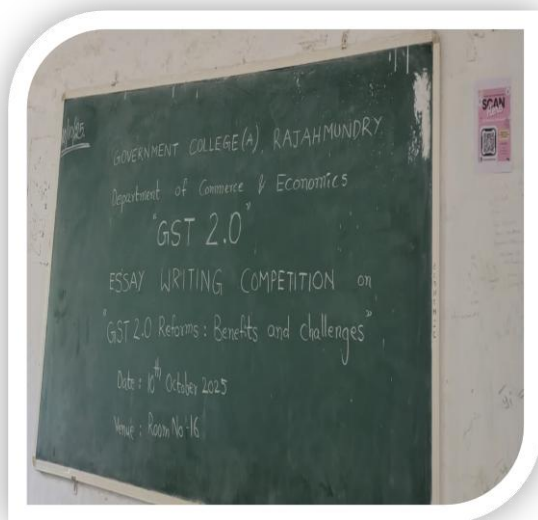
