Introduction





Detailed Report on the First Day – GST 2.0 Awareness Program

Date: 06 October 2025

Introduction

As per the instructions of the Government of Andhra Pradesh, the Department of Commerce and Management Studies & Department of Economics, Government College (Autonomous), Rajahmundry, organized the first day of the “GST 2.0 Awareness Program” on 6th October 2025.

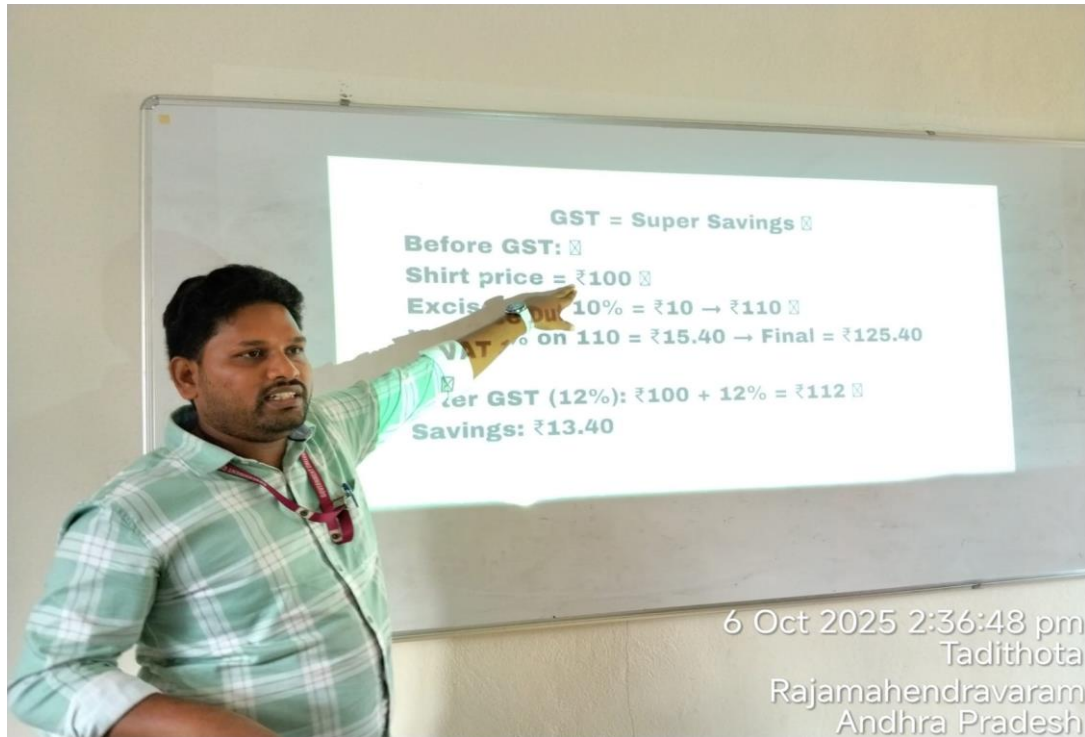

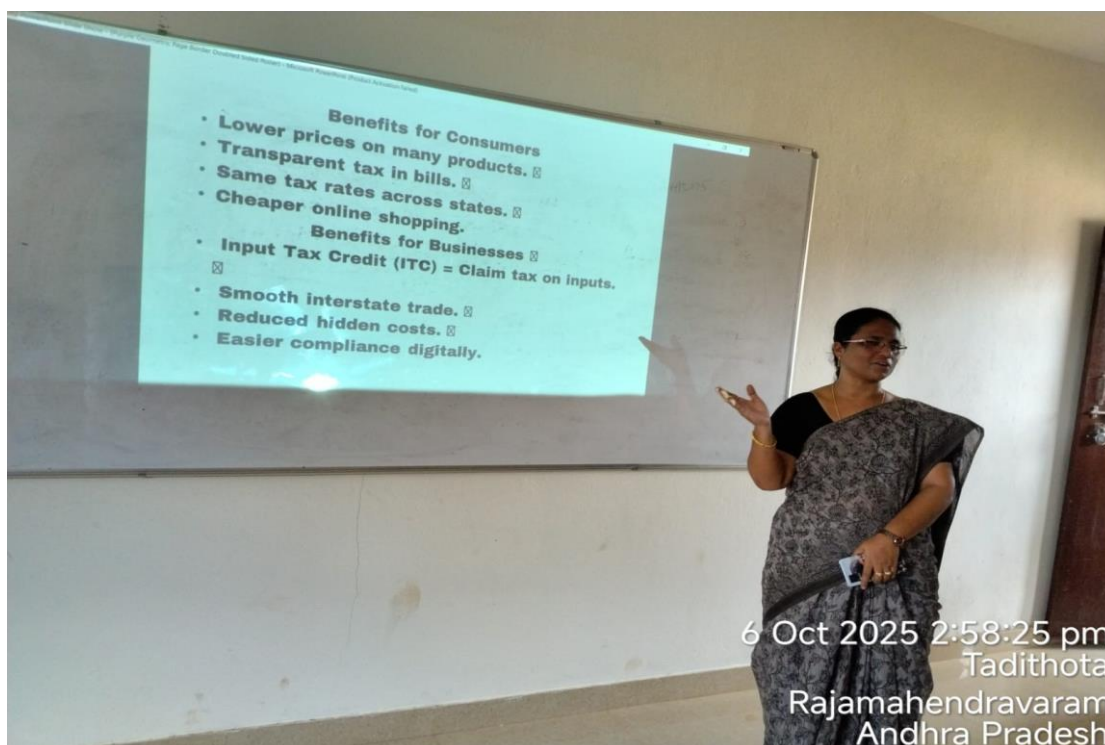

- Practical examples on how GST 2.0 reduces cascading effects and promotes tax compliance

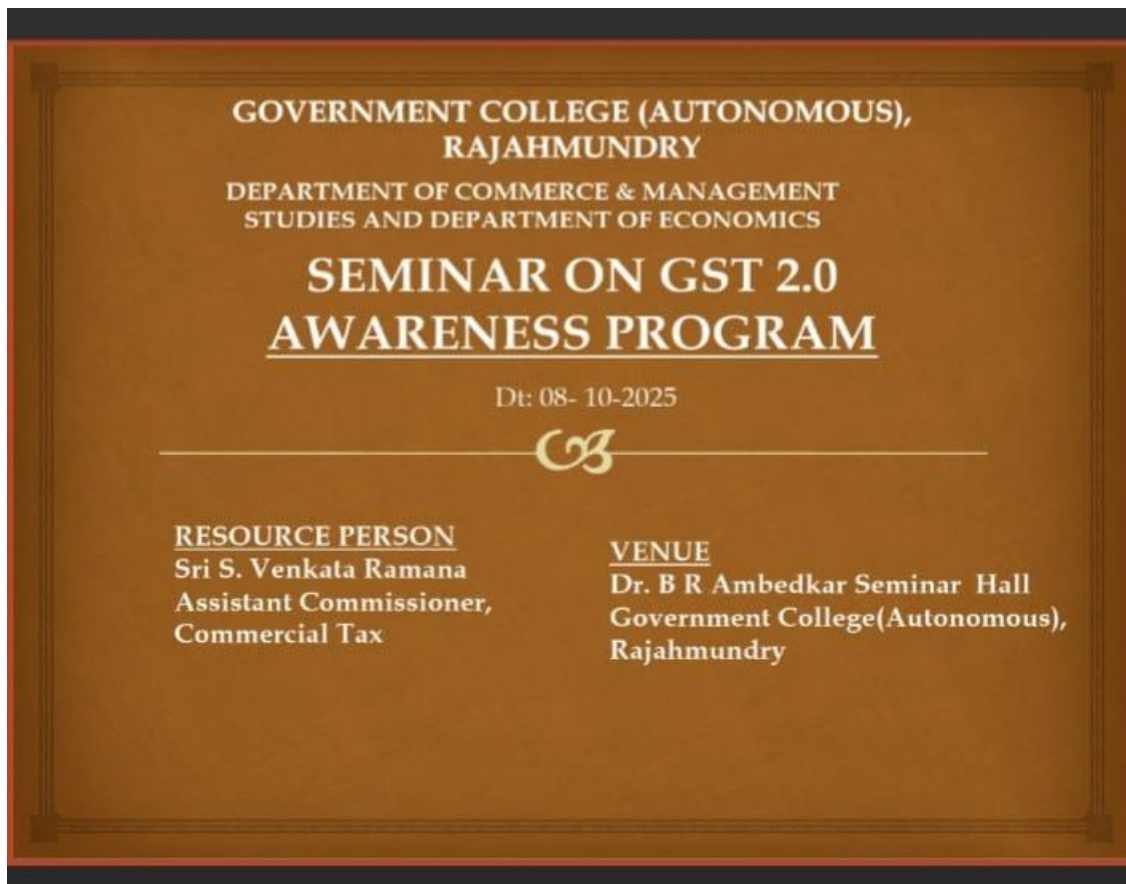

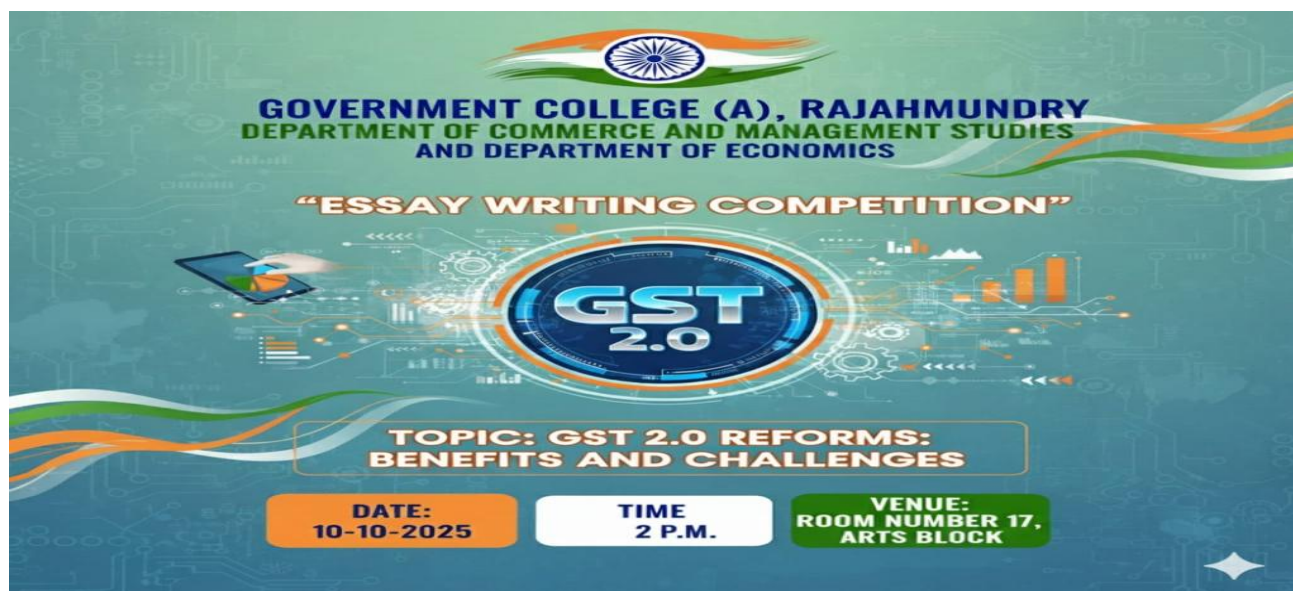

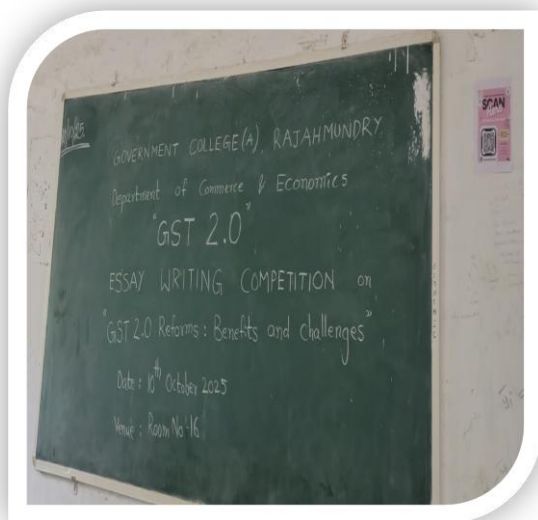
