Importance of World Population Day

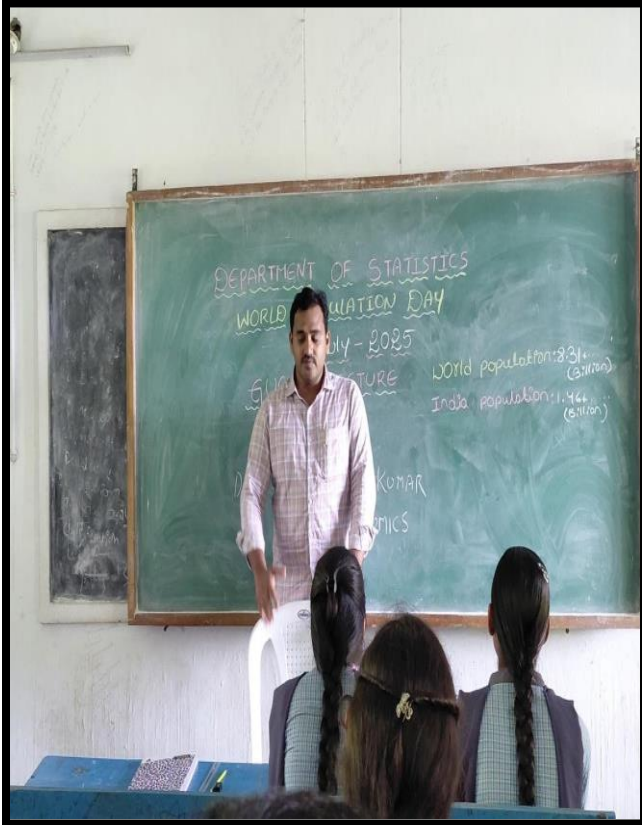
