

3. Term of MOU.

This MOU is effective upon the day and date signed and will be executed by the parties from September 2024 and shall remain in full force and effect for not longer than 5 Years. This MOU may be terminated, without cause, by either party upon two months written notice, which notice shall be delivered by hand or by certified mail to the address listed above.
