Discussion and Resolution:

1. **Constitution of Committee:**
 - It was resolved to constitute a committee in view of the resignation letter received from the existing coordinator consisting of 9 members, with the Principal serving as the Chair of the committee.
 - The committee members will be selected based on their expertise and experience, and the composition will be communicated to all relevant stakeholders within one week.
2. **Appointment of Student Representatives:**
 - It was resolved to appoint 6 student representatives from each year (I, II, III) in both the Science and Arts streams.
 - The selection process for these representatives will be conducted through fair representation from each stream and year.
3. **Discussion on Action Plan:**

- The committee will draft an action plan to address the key issues discussed during the meeting. This plan will include specific goals, timelines, and responsibilities.
- A preliminary version of the action plan will be presented for review and feedback in the next committee meeting scheduled for 12/09/2024.

4. Ragging-Free Campus Formation:

- It was resolved to initiate a comprehensive campaign to ensure a ragging-free campus. This will involve awareness programs, strict enforcement of anti-ragging policies, and the establishment of a grievance redressal mechanism.
- The committee will develop a detailed strategy for this campaign, including the roles of student representatives and faculty members.

5. i) Rally with candle light to protest against violence and injustice faced by women

It was resolved to organize a rally with candlelight to protest against violence and injustice faced by women, and to call for stronger measures to protect their rights. The event will reflect ongoing concerns about safety, equality, and the need for systemic change to address and prevent gender-based violence
